

- Sacrament of the Sick Anointing during 8:00 am Mass on the first Saturday of each month.
- Summer Weekday Masses are held in the Stone Chapel.
- Children's liturgy is offered during the 9:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday.
 After the opening prayer, children 6 years of age and older are invited to the Gast Social Room to listen and reflect on the Sunday readings. They return to the assembly after the homily.

- Children's Offertory is conducted at all weekend liturgies. Nonperishable food/household items are collected for the Food Pantry.
- Fifth Sunday of each month: A food drive for the local food pantry and a special collection for our missionary activities are conducted at all weekend liturgies.

Perpetual Adoration



This year we celebrated 30 years of perpetual adoration at Holy Trinity! In 2008 our new Adoration Chapel was built adjacent to the Father Quigley Faith Formation Center. It is in the middle of our campus and features seating for 40 patrons, eight custom-built stained-

glass windows featuring the seven corporal works of mercy, a large stained-glass cross on the front wall, stations of the cross, electric votive candles, statues, 24/7 access and dedicated parking on the north. 

The second floor includes the atrium and several dividable banquet rooms and a café for meetings. It is available on a limited basis for parish groups or ministries to use after weekend Masses. Strict guidelines must be followed by groups who are allowed to set up in the lobby. This is necessary to prevent overcrowding in the lobby and allow an even flow of people into and out of the church.





Our Church History



Holy Trinity has a rich history dating all the way back to 1868. The first church building, was built in 1882. In 1910 this building was no longer big enough for the growing congregation, so a new stone church now called the Stone Chapel, as seen here, was built in 1911. The excavation work was done by parishioners to keep the cost low, and the stone was donated from a parishioner's quarry on their farm. The men of the parish used their teams and wagons to haul the rock to the building site, which used approximately 2.8



Sacrament info

Baptisms

Baptisms of children are celebrated on either Sundays following the 11:30 a.m. Mass or after the 4:00 p.m. Mass on the first Saturday of the month in the main church. Parents should be registered in a parish and will have attended a Baptism Preparation Class. Please call the office 913.888.2770 for information, to schedule the Baptism Preparation class and to finalize the date of the Baptism after the class has been completed.

First Reconciliation & Eucharist

Children 2nd grade and above may begin preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist. This focused preparation is offered through our Christian

Formation Office for those in our public school system and in Holy Trinity School. Children are expected to be receiving ongoing formal religious education through Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, GIFT, Home Study or Holy Trinity School in addition to preparation for the sacraments. Confirmation

Confirmation is ordinarily celebrated in the 8th grade. Candidates are expected to participate in ongoing faith formation through Junior High Ministry, Home Study or Holy Trinity School in addition to preparation for Confirmation. This sacrament, usually celebrated in the spring, is scheduled by the Archbishop's office. For more information please contact Kathleen Willis at 913.895.0607. For adults who wish to receive this sacrament, please contact Deacon Stuart Holland at 913.895.0606.

Marriage

Preparation for marriage is a minimum of a 9 month process. This preparation time is an opportunity to reflect on your sacramental marriage

as a beautiful living witness of God's love for us. For couples seeking a wedding, either they or their parents must be registered at Holy Trinity. Contact Marsha Holland at 913.895.0608 at the parish office to begin this process.

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the Sick is held on the first Saturday of the month at the 8:00 a.m. Mass. If you are in the need of a priest during the day please call the parish office at 913.888.2770. On evenings or weekends, call the rectory at 913.888.6574 and you will be assisted as soon as possible.

Rite of Christian Initiations (RCIA)

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) is the process individuals enter into when they want to explore the Catholic faith and its beliefs, with the possibility of becoming a full member of the Catholic Church. This journey of faith is an ongoing process and is open to all adults and children over 7 years of age who have never been baptized and to those who have been baptized but never received confirmation. Christian Formation for Children

As a parish, we support life-long faith formation for all ages. Our vision is that all individuals participate in on-going faith formation their entire lives. We recognize this may look very different for individuals depending upon age, circumstance, etc., so we offer different models to fit different schedules. For school-age children we have several options:



- Catholic school
- GIFT sessions twice a month
- weekly Catechesis of the Good Shepherd sessions
- Family Home Study

All are excellent ways to grow in our faith. Those preparing to receive a sacrament for the first time will have focused sessions in addition to their general faith formation sessions. For children who have not been baptized, we have an RCIA process that culminates with the child celebrating Baptism, 1st Communion and Confirmation.

Growing in Faith Together (GIFT)



In Holy Trinity's GIFT program, families experience God together in a program that exposes them to prayer, scripture, doctrine, and liturgy. Emphasis will be placed on family life, supporting households as "domestic church." These are called catechetical assemblies since we come together as a larger family



- Our GIFT Catechetical Assemblies are designed for families with children in 1st through 6th grade.
- We generally meet twice a month on Wednesday evenings from 6-8 p.m.
- One parent (or other adult) is expected to attend with the child (we welcome the entire family)
- Every meeting includes a meal for the family
- Sessions run from September to May
- Sessions are held in the Fr. Quigley Faith Formation Center

Family Home Study

Holy Trinity's Family Home Study program is an opportunity for the entire family to share in the experience of catechesis on their own time schedule at home. This program:

- Is for kindergarten through 6th grade
- You pick the day and time of your choosing
- You will receive monthly mailings
- It can be year round but is typically during the school year
- It includes two sessions for the parents and children (one in the fall and one in the spring)

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Holy Trinity offers Catechesis of the Good
Shepherd (CGS) to all youth, ages 3-12 years old.
Located on the top floor of the Father Quigley
Center, CGS has its own atrium space with 7 different

atria, designed to peacefully nurture your child's faith. Materials used in CGS were designed to meet the developmental needs of the child and are based on the Montessori method of education. This program is fueled by volunteers and has been a part of Holy Trinity for 20 years! There are still spots to enroll your child or become a Catechist yourself.

- Weekly sessions run from October to May
- If your child attends our Early Education Center or Holy Trinity School (up until 1st grade) CGS is included as part of their day
- Children not enrolled in our Early Education Center or School can also attend. After school time options include 4:30-6:15 pm and 6:00-7:45 pm.
- Registration fee is \$90 for one child, but please let us know if there is financial hardship. No one is turned away because of inability to pay.



- In the atrium, the only teacher is Christ. The catechist proclaims the Word and listens with the child, allowing God and the child to build a relationship.
- By interacting with the materials based on the Montessori method, children learn about the Kingdom of God, the Sacraments, the life of Jesus, and other elements of the Catholic faith tradition.
- During each atrium session, children are allowed to work at their own pace and are encouraged to listen for the voice of Jesus in their hearts.

Life Teen

From weekly meetings, retreats, small group studies, events, and more our Youth Ministry's mission is to bring 7th-12th grade students closer to God by helping them live better lives together as family.

We want to become a family of shared lives and shared experiences where healthy relationships and engaging encounters help us to discover God and our Catholic faith. From this discovery, we are compelled to a way of life and to share it with the world. Every Sunday night after our 5pm Mass, we host gatherings for both our junior high and high school students.




