## Worship at Shiloh

- 9:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings, Shiloh offers a traditional
  worship service lead by the Chancel Choir that takes place in the
  Sanctuary. The music incorporates hymns, piano, organ and other
  instruments on various occasions. If you are looking for a service
  that has energy and structure, this is the service for you.
- **11:00 a.m.** service on Sunday offers a spirit-filled encounter with God. The style of worship is modern, the dress is casual, and the service takes place in the Fellowship Hall (Gym).

#### THE SACRAMENTS

As United Methodists, we believe in two sacraments: Baptism and Holy Communion. We believe in one baptism, and a baptism performed in other Christian Churches is valid for membership.

**HOLY COMMUNION** is celebrated the first Sunday of each month in all services, on Maundy Thursday, and other special occasions. We serve the elements in the pews and by intinction.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

At Shiloh, membership is open to all who profess Jesus Christ as Lord and promise to be loyal to the United Methodist Church by their prayers, their presence, their gifts, their service, and their witness. Baptism is a prerequisite. Membership classes are offered throughout the year, and confirmation classes are offered once a year for youth.

#### WEDDINGS

Our Church is available for weddings. The local clergy perform the services. Arrangements are made through the church office.

## Shiloh's History

In 1818, a group of pioneer inhabitants formed a "class" with meeting and worship held in their Delhi Township homes.

In 1828, Peter Williams, a member and Trustee, deeded an acre of land for \$30.00 to build a house of worship and to provide a place for burial. Completed in 1830, Shiloh's original Sanctuary stands on Anderson Ferry Road, next to the old cemetery.

During the first century of its existence, circuit pastors and student ministers served the congregation, and services were held in the afternoons. In the 1920's, 1930's, and in the early 1940's, part-time and retired ministers served the needs of the congregation. The first full-time minister was appointed in 1947. From 1948 to 2017, 12 full-time ministers have been appointed to serve Shiloh United Methodist Church.

Church membership in 1931 was 41 and 45 were enrolled in the Sunday School. By 1951, the membership was 143, and it was recorded at 470 in 1958. During the 1950's, the significant growth of population in Delhi Township and the increasing growth of membership necessitated the enlargement of the original Sanctuary.

A summary of significant Official Board action during this period of rapid expansion included: the purchase of a lot and residence (east of the cemetery) for use as a parsonage, addition to the east side of the original church building to provide a kitchen, classrooms and lavatories (later this addition served as the Pastor's study and the Church secretary's office). In 1952, there was a groundbreaking for a new Educational Building (present Administrative Wing) and enlargement of the parsonage and Sanctuary.

On June 1, 1958, groundbreaking ceremonies for a new Sanctuary were held. The Cornerstone Laying was November 16, 1958, and on October 25, 1959, the Consecration Service was held in the new 400 seat Sanctuary.

Early in the 1960's, the dedication of the organ and tower chimes occurred. Additional land east of the Parsonage was purchased to provide additional parking facilities. In 1964, the Thomas property (south of the original sanctuary) was purchased. The completed Education Building and Fellowship Hall were consecrated, and dedication of the debt-free Sanctuary occurred in 1966.

The decade of the '70's included the first Pictorial Directory, installation of the Sanctuary window symbols, celebration of 150 years of Methodism (1826-1976), and the presentation of a bronze plaque by the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), which was placed in the original Sanctuary for being the oldest continuously used church in Western Hamilton County.

The decade of the '80's brought the dedication of the etching symbols (5) in the divider between the Narthex and Sanctuary, dedication of the first handicap ramp, sponsorship and assistance in resettlement of a refugee family, and the groundbreaking celebration of the parlor and renovation of the Administrative Wing.

The 1990's began with the Consecration Service of Worship and ritual of laying the cornerstone for the addition of the parlor. 1993 was the year for celebrating the 175th year of the founding of Shiloh. In 1994, the dedication of memorials the Advent paraments and the exterior sign - was held.

On November 9, 2008, a groundbreaking ceremony was conducted and construction shortly began on the Shiloh Community Building. A consecration service was held on February 7, 2010, with Bishop Bruce Ough consecrating the new addition.

As Shiloh strives to meet the growing needs of our congregation and community, we continue to be an integral and vital part of Delhi Township, ministering not only to the needs of our members, but to the needs of our communities, nation, and the world.


