Program Committees

Christian Education

This department shall supervise and administer the church school, including the recruitment and training of all church school staff and teachers. It shall supervise and administer the special classes, schools for Christian living, forums, and other programs to enrich the lives of the members for the congregation. It shall supervise the Christian Youth Fellowship program and the Chi Rho program in the church. Assists with provisions for both the church libraries-children and adult.

Evangelism

This committee shall develop a concern for evangelism in the entire membership of the church and plan and administer special evangelistic programs. It shall plan and carry out programs of publicity for the church. It shall nurture new members into the life of the church.

Membership

This committee shall be responsible for stimulating the widest possible interest on the part of the entire membership of the church in all the affairs of the congregation.

Pastoral Care

This ministry facilitates several ministries to serve its members and friends with God's love and compassion.

Personnel

This committee shall be the intermediary between the Official Board and all paid staff members. The department shall, both individually and collectively, meet with the staff to review areas of concern.

Property

This committee shall be responsible for the supervision of the church buildings, parsonages, vehicles, and all general equipment, including the care, repair, decoration, and protection of such equipment.

Public Relations

This committee shall raise awareness for the theological basis of the church, increase attendance at services and events and promote membership in the church by making more people aware of church activities, service projects and opportunities to worship and grow in faith.

Stewardship and Finance

This committee shall prepare the church budget for the next succeeding calendar year and shall review, approve, and coordinate the budgets submitted by the chairpersons for the Functional Departments.

World Outreach

This committee shall be responsible for stimulating the widest possible interest in and support of the church's program of missions and benevolence.

Worship and Fine Arts

This committee shall be responsible for planning the public worship services of the church and the stimulation of adequate and effective worship in the various auxiliary organizations of the church.

Children are placed in classrooms with other children within 1 years range of their age. The number of children in the 1 year old class is limited to 10; the 2 year old classes are limited to 12 and the 3 & 4 year old classes are limited to 16 children; all classrooms have two teachers.

Children may attend one or more days per week.

Teachers are trained in CPR, First Aid, Defibrillator.
