**PARISH MEMBERSHIP** - All are welcome! To join the parish simply stop by the Parish Office and someone will gladly provide you with a registration packet and talk to you about all the ways you can get involved. You may also call the Parish Office and request a packet of materials with registration forms to be sent to you. Ask any staff member at any activity or after Mass and they can provide information to you.

Shortly after you have registered you will be invited to a Pastor’s Welcome Gathering to learn more about SMM and how you can get connected with the St. Margaret Mary Catholic Community.

**INFANT BAPTISM** - The Sacrament of Baptism is ordinarily celebrated on a Sunday afternoon at 1:15 p.m. most months of the year and is also available during Mass upon request. Contact the Parish Office to schedule arrangements. Families are required to participate in a Baptism Preparation process if they have not done so in the past 3 years.

**MARRIAGE** - Couples should contact the parish office soon after engagement, but at a minimum of six months before the proposed wedding date. Parish wedding guidelines regarding music, decorations, photography, etc. will be provided to you. Pre-marriage counseling is an Archdiocesan requirement, and we provide several options for engaged couples. The bride, groom or their family should be a member of the parish.

**RCIA** - (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) RCIA is for anyone interested in learning more about the Catholic faith or interested in becoming Catholic. RCIA sessions meet on Sundays with dismissal at the 10:00 a.m. Mass with Breaking Open the Word. Catechetical sessions continue immediately following from 11:15 to 12:30. Call the parish office for more information.

**SCHOOL ADMISSION POLICY** - School admission is independent of parish membership, but active participating parishioners are given first priority. Contact the School Office for additional information.



## PARISH HISTORY

Saint Margaret Mary Parish was established by a decree of Louisville’s Archbishop John A. Floerish on December 4, 1950. Father Ehrich J. Stuart was assigned as pastor and given the task of building the new parish. His official duties began on February 28, 1951.

Property on Arterburn Drive was purchased in November 1951. The home constructed on this property eventually became the parish rectory. Less than a year later, on October 17, 1952, the cornerstone of the church was laid. The first Mass was celebrated in the newly dedicated church on August 2, 1953.

Saint Margaret Mary School opened one month later. Staffed with seven Ursuline Sisters from Mount St. Joseph, the school sought to respond to the needs of parents wanting a Catholic education for their children. Enrollment grew quickly, and construction of a larger facility began in the summer of 1956. In June 1973, Father Stuart announced his retirement and Father C. Patrick Creed was appointed to succeed him as pastor.

In 1975, a renovation of the church and school was undertaken that included the construction of Stuart Hall (our current gym). After seven years, Father Creed was transferred, and Father James E. Wafzig assumed his duties as pastor in 1980. His seven years of service as pastor saw a marked increase in the level of lay involvement and ministry throughout the parish community.

The fourth pastor, Father Nick Rice, came to St. Margaret Mary in January 1987. Under his direction, the parish continued its growth, both in membership and in spiritual development as a faith community. On April 14, 1991 ground was broken for the construction of a new worship space. The present church was dedicated on October 17, 1992, forty years after the cornerstone was laid for the original church.

On January 19, 1994, Father B.J. Breen left his position as Chancellor for the Archdiocese and was installed as the fifth pastor. As Father Breen led the parish through a year of special activities to celebrate our parish’s 50th Anniversary in 2001, St. Margaret Mary also enjoyed the completion of the parish’s most recent construction project, which included the Pastoral Center and renovation and expansion of our school. The growing parish school was granted the prestigious “Blue Ribbon” status in the fall of 2004, and the fall of 2006 saw the school at a full complement of three classrooms per grade level. National Blue Ribbon status was awarded for a second time in 2015.

The sixth pastor, Father Stephen Pohl, was installed by Archbishop Joseph Kurtz on August 24, 2008. Under Fr. Pohl's leadership the Sacred Heart Spirituality Center was purchased, and the Schantz Organ was installed in May 2015. On October 15, 2015 Fr. William Hammer was installed as our seventh and current pastor.

We continue to evaluate the needs of our thriving parish of approximately 2,045 families and 6,055 members. Our mission statement stresses the importance of discipleship: To be disciples who know, love, and serve God.

Thanks to parishioners living out their Baptismal call, St. Margaret Mary is a wonderful, supportive community in which we celebrate God's blessings and love for us. The Sacraments, especially the Eucharist, provide the grace-filled motivation and momentum from which we go forth in love and service to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ!

## STEWARDSHIP - A WAY OF LIFE

Stewardship is a way of life at St. Margaret Mary. It is "what we do after we say we believe" in all aspects of our lives — at home, at work, and at church. Each fall we have an official stewardship renewal using Stewardship Commitment Cards, so parishioners can recommit themselves to God through their participation in our parish community.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus offers us a definitive understanding of discipleship. He said, "I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." John 13:34-35

To understand what he means by this "new law" we should look no further than the cross. On the cross Jesus gives himself completely and as his followers, we are called to do the same thing.

In terms of stewardship, this means that the Old Testament notion of stewardship "tithing" (giving 10%) is just the entry point. As Christians, we are called to love as Christ loves, which means that we give ourselves completely. We offer our very lives and all we have as a total self-gift to God for the sake of others. As an expression of gratitude, we offer our total self-gift 100% as what it means to live the Gospel, and it is what we all strive to do every day.

If you work a forty-hour work week, 10% of your time might mean giving 4 hours to God in the form of weekly Mass attendance, prayer and spiritual formation. Giving 10% of your talent means getting involved in regular parish activities. In practical terms this may fluctuate with time, but it often begins with an initial desire to be an active part of the parish family. From there we strive to offer ourselves completely, after the example of Christ Jesus.



At St. Margaret Mary, stewardship means three things, one is not more important or does not take the place of another.

1. We give our **time** to God each week by worshipping together as a community and by seeking opportunities for our spiritual development (e.g. Bible studies, Men's and Women's Ministry, receiving the Sacraments, etc.)
2. We give our **talent** by involving ourselves in regular parish activities and through community service (e.g. liturgical ministries, parish committees, service groups, involvement in our school)
3. We give our **treasure** by offering our first fruits, 10% of our combined salary; for some it might be 5% to the parish and 5% to other charities.

## STEWARDSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

The following committees, ministries, boards, organizations, and services are the life of the St. Margaret Mary Catholic Community. They represent the many opportunities that are available for parishioners to get involved in the community to help further bring about the kingdom of Jesus Christ.

The Parish Council, Coordinating Committees, and board positions are filled either by election or appointment. Parishioners are always welcome to attend, but should you have a need to put an issue on the meeting agenda, advanced notice is needed.

### **PARISH COUNCIL**

The purpose of the Parish Council is to be advisory to the Pastor. It offers him counsel and helps to establish policies and set broad goals and objectives. It serves as a structure for constructive dialogue among the pastor, staff, and laity of the parish to effect cooperation and direction as a Christian community. It carries out the guidelines and directives issued by the Archbishop of Louisville and the Pastoral Council of the Archdiocese. The Parish Council is, in areas designated by the Pastor, the official decision-making body of the parish, and all decisions are considered official upon ratification by the Pastor.

The Parish Council acts as the coordinating body for all organizations and group activities within the parish. It surveys the needs both spiritual and temporal of the parish, community, and the Archdiocese, as well as, develops and directs implementation of programs directed at fulfilling those needs. The Parish Council sets priorities to establish goals and objectives to meet those needs.

The Parish Council offers the Pastor counsel and is an extension of the Pastor, Associate Pastor, and assigned staff, and exercises authority under the jurisdiction of the Pastor. Its objective is to furnish guidance, information, and explanation of its work and progress to parishioners at all times. Parish Council meets the fourth Tuesday of every month. A term on the Parish Council is for three years.

**SERVICE COORDINATING COMMITTEE**


