

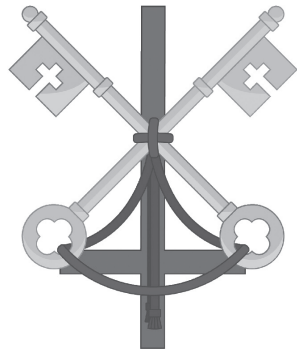

St. Peter is a Roman Catholic parish in the city of Geneva and part of the Aurora Deanery within the Rockford Diocese. We are the parish home for a vibrant, faith-filled community of more than 2,600 families, many of whom have worshipped and learned as part of the St. Peter community for generations. While these parish families represent a strong, continuous thread in our parish history, new individuals and families are warmly welcomed into the parish family. We serve the Lord through prayer, faith, service, care of creation, sacrificial giving and evangelization. Our parish community adheres to traditional Catholic practices and is known for its rich liturgical celebrations and devotion to the Sacraments, particularly the Eucharist. The Blessed Sacrament receives special reverence through our Adoration Chapel. There are many opportunities to serve and be served within this parish home. We sponsor over 60 ministries and organizations that help the church members, local community and beyond in a variety of ways. Fr. Bakkelund is our Pastor. Fr. Warren is our Parochial Vicar. We are blessed to have Deacon Greg D'Anna serving our parish, helping with baptisms, some marriage matters, prayer services, special blessings, assisting at Masses, ministering to parishioners and more. Northwestern Delnor Hospital is within our parish boundaries. Together with other tri-city parishes, we are responsible for pastoral care of all Catholic patients during their stay in the hospital. This is also the case for BRIA Nursing Home and Rehabilitation Center, Arden Courts and GreenFields of Geneva. We are blessed with help from neighboring priests and pastoral care ministers who share this responsibility with us.

Most of our parish families reside in Geneva, but we have also attracted singles and families from many other communities. We ask that our parishioners become an active part of our parish through participation in worship, spiritual growth activities, service to others and financial support. Our parish, most importantly, is one made up of God's children regardless of age, gender or race.


