Welcome to the Catholic Church of the Incarnation Guide Book & Directory!



## Sacraments

## ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is offered to all who are seriously ill or prior to surgery. Please contact the Parish Office when you or a family member is ill.

## **BAPTISM** (of infants)

Baptism preparation class is required for all parents and godparents. These classes provide parents with an awareness of the responsibilities and role of the parents and godparents in educating children in the Catholic faith. Classes are held monthly in English and Spanish. Contact the Parish Office for dates and times of classes and to schedule your child's baptism with a priest or a deacon. You must be a registered parishioner for 6 months prior to Baptism.

#### CONFIRMATION

The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated in the spring when a child is in the eighth grade or above. Children are required to attend P.R.E. classes or have been in a parochial school for the year prior to receiving the sacrament. Contact P.R.E. for dates and times of classes.

## FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Office of Parish Religious Education .......853-0135

First Holy Communion is normally celebrated during the spring when children are in the second grade. Children are required to attend P.R.E. classes or have been in a parochial school for the year prior to receiving the sacrament. Contact P.R.E. for dates and times of classes.

## FIRST RECONCILIATION

First Reconciliation is normally celebrated in late fall when children are in the second grade. Children are required to attend P.R.E. classes or have been in a parochial school for the year prior to receiving the sacrament. Contact P.R.E. for dates and times of classes.

## **FUNERALS**

Funerals are celebrated at the convenience of the family. Please contact the Parish Office when there is a death in the family.

## HOLY ORDERS/RELIGIOUS VOCATION

If you are interested in pursuing a vocation to the priesthood, the permanent deaconate or as a religious brother or sister, please contact Fr. Mike or Fr. José.

## MARRIAGE

The Sacrament of Matrimony is initiated by an appointment with a priest or deacon <u>six months</u> in advance of the proposed wedding date. Diocesan Pre-Marriage Education class is required. One member of the wedding party or their family must be a parish member for at least six months prior to the wedding. Contact the Parish Office six months before the planned date of the wedding for dates of the Diocesan Pre-Marriage Education classes, for individual marriage preparation with a priest or deacon, and also to schedule the facilities. Facilities are available for receptions. The Parish Office can furnish details as to availability and cost.

## RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is regularly celebrated on Saturday between 3:30 - 4:30 PM and Sundays between 9:30 - 10:00 AM or by an appointment with a priest.

# Ministries of Worship

## ALTAR SERVERS

Altar Servers assist the priests and deacons at all liturgical celebrations in the Church. All Servers must have already received their 1st Communion and gone through Altar Server training. Classes for training are held periodically throughout the year and are announced in the Sunday bulletin. Altar Servers are scheduled 3 months at a time according to their availability and Mass preferences. For more information please contact the Church Office.

## ALTAR SOCIETY

Mary Lou Reed ...... 854-5539

Members of the Altar Society care for the priests' vestments, altar linens, and altar servers' albs.

## **ALTAR FLOWERS**

Parishioners may donate flowers for the altar in the church for any Sunday except during Advent and Lent. Contact the Parish Office to make arrangements.

## **EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION (EMHC)**

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are Adults (18 and over) who have been approved by the pastor and have completed training by the Diocese to assist in the distribution of the Sacrament of the Eucharist at the Holy Mass. They may also assist in Communion Services in the absence of a priest or deacon. Training is provided periodically throughout the year but all participants must have permission from their pastor to attend. All ministers are scheduled 3 months at a time according to their availability and Mass preferences. For more information, please contact the parish office.

## **LECTORS**

Lectors are Adults (18 and over) who proclaim the Word of God at liturgical celebrations. They must be approved by their pastor and complete the Minister of the Word formation training program offered by the Diocesan Ministry of Liturgy and Spirituality. All ministers are scheduled 3 months at a time according to their availability and Mass preferences. For more information, please contact the parish office.

#### SACRISTANS

Barry Love ...... 853-7468

Sacristans are liturgical ministers who assist in preparing and setting up the books, vessels and necessary materials for the celebration of Mass and other liturgies. They are also responsible for organizing and cleaning up the sacristy and sanctuary after each liturgical celebration. For more information, please contact the parish office.

#### **USHERS**

Ushers greet parishioners, assist with seating and take up the offering. There is always a need for ushers; no prior training is required. Ushers are scheduled according to Mass preference.

## MINISTRY OF THE SICK

Ministers of the Sick are EMHC who have been trained and commissioned to represent our Church community by visiting and bringing the Holy Eucharist to those of our parish family who are sick, elderly or homebound and are unable to be present at Mass. Call the parish office (853-7468) or the Social Ministry Office (853-8574) to make visiting arrangements.

## **Faith Formation**

## PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Parish Religious Education (PRE) classes are held on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings and are taught by capable, devoted volunteer catechists guiding the youth through various levels of our Catholic faith. Classes are held on Sundays from 9:15-10:15 AM for 1st-8th grades. Classes are on Mondays from 5:30-6:30 PM, grades 1-8, and on Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30 PM are for 1st-8th grades plus High School Confirmation Preparation. Children with Special needs are mainstreamed into the regular classroom or are worked with one on one as requested by the parent. Religion classes run from August through April. Vacation Bible School takes place for one week in June.

#### YOUTH

#### HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH MINISTRY

9th - 12th Grades

Incarnation Teens is a ministry that seeks to form the hearts and minds of high school youth by incorporating prayer and worship, teaching, service, leadership development, and social activities throughout the year. Incarnation Teens is a safe and welcoming environment of Christian virtue that helps these youth learn how to lead an integrated life during these formative years.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL YOUTH MINISTRY

This ministry welcomes all 6th - 8th grade youth in the parish. The Middle School Youth Ministry provides these youth with opportunities to grow closer to Jesus Christ, to learn more about the teachings of the Catholic Church, to answer the Christian call to service and to have fellowship with each other. The Middle School Youth Ministry seeks to help youth integrate their Catholic beliefs into their daily activities.

## FISHERS OF MEN

Fishers of Men is a program for the Spiritual Formation for men. To engage men in exploring, developing, and deepening their faith in Christ to become better husbands, fathers, brothers, and Christian male role models in the community based on Scripture Study and guided reflection on how Christ is working in their lives.

## RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

The Catholic Church welcomes new initiates into the faith through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). The formation begins with weekly sessions each fall and continues through the Easter Season. The formation program is for Catholics who may have missed some of the Sacraments, non-Catholic adults who have been baptized into other denominations (candidates), and unbaptized adults (catechumens) who feel called to a full communion with Christ and His Church. The weekly sessions are also open to anyone who would like to know more about the Catholic faith and have a better understanding of who Jesus Christ is, and what the Catholic Church teaches and believes.

## **SCRIPTURE STUDY**

A journey to learn more about our God, our faith and our distinct Catholic heritage meets weekly from September through May. The material is faithful to Catholic teaching with references to the Catechism & papal writings.

## SMALL CHURCH COMMUNITY

The Light of the World Evangelization Retreat offers each participant the opportunity to attend the six week "Growing in Christ" seminar that follows the Retreat. After the six weekly group sessions, participants are enthusiastic about forming into Small Church Communities that meet at a time convenient to each Community. Initial leadership is provided to help each Community learn to praise, study, serve, and pray together. If you have an interest in the Small Church Communities at Incarnation Catholic Church but have not had the opportunity to attend a Retreat, call and we will be glad to help you get connected.

## INCARNATION PRESCHOOL

Incarnation Preschool was established in January 2000. Our program accepts children ages 1 to 5 years old. We currently offer two, three and five day programs in addition to Before and After Care. We provide a loving, happy, Christian environment for children to learn and grow. The curriculum is academic-based which prepares the foundation for kindergarten. All areas of a child's development are addressed; spiritual, social, cognitive, motor, language and self-help through developmentally appropriate practices. Christian education is incorporated into our curriculum through daily prayer and monthly chapel visits. Music is also offered. ## **CARE MINISTRY**

## **COFFEE BAR**

The Coffee Bar Ministry is designed to create an occasion for fellowship following the 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM Masses each weekend and to provide an opportunity for our parishioners to get to know and catch up with one another each week. Volunteers are always welcome and needed to join in the preparation and set up each week.

## COLUMBIAN SQUIRES - Blessed Frassati Circle #5424

Columbian Squires, the official youth group of the Knights of Columbus, is open to Catholic young men ages 10-17. Squires focus on serving our parish and community through development of skills and attitudes of Catholic Leadership. In the words of Brother Barnabas McDonald, "The supreme purpose of the Columbian Squires is character building." Investitures for membership occur 2 or 3 times per year. Circle meetings typically occur at 2:30 PM on the second Sunday of every month.

## ESL: (English as a Second Language)

English as a Second Language is a 24 week course specially designed for those whose first language is not English. We have had students from Brazil, Taiwan, China, India, Mexico, and Argentina. ## FOOD PANTRY

Social Ministry Office maintains a food pantry. It is stocked with donations from parishioners of non-perishable food items for use by those in need, in and around our parish community. When the supply is low, parishioners are asked to help re-stock the pantry in order to help those in temporary need. Those in need may receive a bag of food once a month with two matching forms (one with a picture) of identification.

## FRIENDLY VISIT

Provides support for homebound parishioners; those living in assisted living facilities and nursing homes.

## GOD'S SPECIAL NEEDS

## **GREETERS**

## **HELPING HANDS (Food Angels)**

Food staples, household cleaning supplies and toiletries are collected each month for the poor of Fayette County. Donations should be placed in the brown tubs located between the doors in the big Narthex. They are distributed after the Loaves and Fishes collection the first weekend of each month. School supplies are collected in July. During Advent we have an "Angel Tree." Each "angel" identifies an item needed for the Christmas distribution. Parishioners are invited to take an angel and replace it with the unwrapped item. These are then delivered to the needy in time for Christmas. Project Outreach also sponsors "Loaves and Fishes." This event happens the first weekend of every month. Non-perishable food items can be left in the containers outside the new narthex doors. They are collected after each Mass and distributed by our parish food pantry and Project Outreach. Items can always be left in the brown tubs in the new narthex.

#### SCOUTING:

## **BOY SCOUTS**

All boys ages 11-18 are welcome to join this group for a variety of scouting experiences. Meetings are held on Monday nights from 7:00-8:30 PM. This is a year round program built by volunteers and carried out by the scouts.

## **CUB SCOUTS**

All boys in 1st through 5th grades are welcome to join. Den and pack meetings are held during the months of September – May on Tuesday evenings. We have special events, such as camping trips, Pinewood Derby races, picnics, parties, and service projects. ## **VIRTUS TRAINING**

To continue its commitment to the safety of our children, our diocese requires that ALL adult teachers and volunteers complete the one-time training class, "Protecting our Children". This program not only informs adults about the seriousness of child sexual abuse, but equips them to help prevent assaults before they occur.
