Confirmation

Youth in seventh and eighth grades or older who have not yet been confirmed as church members may participate in confirmation classes. Confirmation classes usually begin in the fall and continue through April. Contact our Youth Ministries Director at hannahewald@powellumc.org for more information.

Scheduling a Wedding

To book a wedding, contact our Office and Finance Administrator, (614) 847-3703, to check date availability and complete a Wedding Application Form. If the date, a minister, and appropriate staff are available, the wedding may be scheduled. You do not need to be a church member to be married at Powell United Methodist Church. A minimum of three pre-marital counseling sessions is required. The church Wedding Policy explains all fees and rules regarding weddings and is available from the church office.

Sponsoring Altar Flowers

A sign-up chart is located at the Welcome Center. Altar flowers may be given in honor or in memory of someone. Flowers may be taken home after Sunday services. The church orders the arrangements on your behalf. The cost is \$45 per arrangement. Checks should be made payable to the church with Altar Flowers noted in the memo line.

Reporting a Change of Address

Changes of address, phone number and email should be reported to the church office, (614) 847-3703, emailed to office@powellumc.org, or recorded in the notebooks passed on Sunday mornings.

Scheduling a Room or Event

To schedule a room, contact our Office and Finance Administrator, (614) 847-3703 or office@powellumc.org. All individuals wishing to schedule a room must complete an 'Application for Use of Facilities' form, which is available in the church office or via email. Nominal usage fees are charged for room usage by outside organizations and for-profit groups. Lesser donations/fees are requested from members and non-profit groups for room usage. Church functions take priority over usage by outside groups. The 'Church Policy for Room Usage' explains the rules governing room rental/usage and is available in the church office.



Registering for Preschool and Parents' Day Out

Powell United Methodist Church Preschool offers a Parents' Day Out program for children ages 9 months-5 years old, a preschool program for 2's, 3's, and 4's, and a Kindergarten Enrichment program.

Enrollment for the year occurs in January and February. Church members receive priority registration. Contact Linda Franz, Preschool Director, at (614) 847-3773 for more information.

Powell United Methodist Church Organizational Structure

Church Leadership Board - is the govering body of the church. The board consists of 12 chuch members, who will each serve 3 year terms. Board members are divided into subgroups, such as Missions, Finance, Facilities, and Staff.

Endowment Committee - administers the charitable gifts which have been donated to Powell United Methodist Church. Gifts to this fund may be designated by the donor to the Missions Endowment, Church Property Endowment, or General Endowment funds.

Memorial Committee - oversees memorial gifts given to the church.
