Amen.

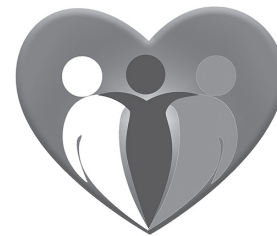
We are a Mission-Focused Parish

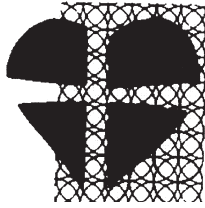

We believe we are called to break down the walls that divide us—accepting, affirming, and accompanying each other, even those with whom we disagree. We seek unity, not uniformity.



When you need help... SMMP provides the following services

When you have recently lost a loved one...

The **Bereavement Ministry** seeks to accompany persons and their families in their journey of grief as they learn to adjust to the absence of their loved one's physical presence and the resulting feelings of pain and loneliness. A bereavement minister is a compassionate person who gives the grieving person the time they need to grieve and listens without making judgment or giving advice. To ask for help from our Bereavement Ministry or to ask for a funeral luncheon contact the parish office 630-369-0777.

When a family emergency makes it difficult to prepare meals...

The **Emergency Meals** group supplies home cooked meals to families in difficult situations (illness, accident, etc.). When you are ill and cannot come to Mass. To ask for emergency meals contact the parish office at 630-369-0777.

The **Pastoral Care Ministers** bring comfort and a caring heart to the sick and homebound of our parish and surrounding areas. We take Holy Communion to those who are unable to come to church. We visit parishioners in their homes, or at the hospital; we do a Sunday morning prayer service at Sunrise Assisted Living Home; and we visit people at St. Patrick's Nursing Home. When you need emergency financial assistance...

The **St. Vincent de Paul Society**, a Catholic organization of lay men and women, offers person-to-person service to individuals in need. We give aid to parishioners and those living within our parish boundaries, no matter their faith. This aid may be financial or take the form of intervention or consultation. When you need transportation...

St. Margaret Mary Parish offers free non-emergency transportation to parishioners who are unable to drive or without a means of transportation. Requests for rides are taken at least 48 hours in advance. To schedule a ride contact the parish office at 630-369-0777.

When you need check-in help for seniors or shut-ins ...

The Sunshine Ministry makes daily phone calls to seniors and shut-ins to make sure they are well and to provide emotional support. If necessary they can also contact neighbors and family members to do follow up. For information for signing up a friend or loved one for this service contact the parish office, 630-369-0777.

When you need help with child care during Mass...

Our parish provides a free babysitting service during the 10:00 Mass. For more information, contact the parish office at 630-369-0777.

When you are dealing with separation, divorce, death or loss of a relationship...

New Beginnings' purpose is to support people through these difficult experiences. We focus on the physical, intellectual, emotional and spiritual growth of our members and provide an atmosphere where members feel safe in social situations. 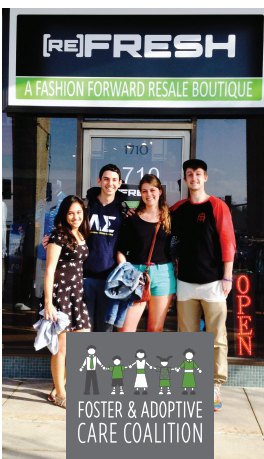

Adults...

A wide range of programs focusing on faith formation throughout adulthood is offered. These include: Bible Study, Morning and Evening Enrichment presentations, Saturday Morning Live which address ethical and spiritual dilemmas in the workplace, and Table for Two, an intimate candlelight dinner and presentation to enrich married life, preached retreats and days of reflection, and individual spiritual direction, to name a few.



We Serve at SMMP

Big Day of Service ...

Beginning in 2017, the Education and Service Commissions come together, under the guidance of the Parish Council to serve our parish and the community at this annual event. Various service opportunities are setup to take place on a specific Saturday. Parishioners, extended family, friends and the community are invited to sign up to serve others on this day.

BSA Scouts & Cub Scouts ...

Our parish has both a Cub Scout Pack and a BSA Scout Troop that meet in our building and do service projects in the parish throughout the community. Both girls and boys are welcome in our Scout organizations.

Charitable Contributions...

St. Margaret Mary Parish donates to organizations which serve the needy. A committee allocates these funds based upon human needs including feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, and providing for the physical and spiritual well-being of individuals and groups.

Christmas Giving Tree...

gives parishioners a chance to share Christmas gifts and food with families in need.

Comfort Care Funeral Luncheons & Emergency Meals

The Funeral Luncheon Committee provides a luncheon, at no charge, following a funeral for up to 250 people in the Parish Center. Emergency meals are also prepared by this group, upon request.

Daybreak Transitional Housing...

is a ministry that provides housing and supportive services to homeless families, while they work toward permanent housing and a quality of life that supports their needs.

DuPage P.A.D.S. ...

P.A.D.S. provides dinner and breakfast, hospitality, laundry, and shelter to the homeless in conjunction with other area churches. SMM parishioners staff our site once a month.

Earth Care Committee...

helps the parish become more eco-friendly; provides resources and opportunities for parishioners to care for creation; and advocates for environmentally responsible government policies and legislation.

Food Pantry Ministry...

Encourages parishioners to regularly donate non-perishable food items and delivers donations to Loaves & Fishes Community Services.

Holiday Food Baskets...

This committee works with local social service agencies to provide Easter and Christmas food baskets to families in need.

Knights of Columbus...

This local chapter provides opportunities for service in the parish and in the wider community.

Legion of Mary...

Its stated mission is for active members to serve God under the banner of Mary by the corporal and spiritual works of Mercy. The main activities include door to door evangelization, inviting all to our parish with a weekly bulletin, looking for any needs such as religious articles, materials, elderly needs and asking if homes have been blessed.

Men's Club...

This group strives to serve God, each other, our parish and community in a spirit of camaraderie. They organize charitable activities such as April in Parish, and sponsor family activities such as the annual parish picnic and the annual family pizza night.

Military Ministry...

This is a support group for all veterans and currently serving soldiers. We also lend a hand for those in need. We mail letters, boxes of personal items, valentines and Christmas cards as well as having a prayer group. We also wish to support the families of soldiers.



Parish Blood Drive...

The Knights of Columbus sponsors a semi-annual blood drive.

Peace & Justice Advisory Working Group...

educates parishioners about Catholic Social Teaching; provides advocacy opportunities to parishioners; and seeks to make Catholic Social Teaching a constituent part of parish life.

Pro-L.I.F.E Committee...

The St. Margaret Mary Pro-L.I.F.E. Committee works to spread the pro-life message by following the Bishops' pastoral plan for pro-life activities: **education** (pamphlet rack in atrium, bulletin articles), **pastoral care** (fundraisers to support local pregnancy resource centers), **affecting public policy** (informing parishioners of federal & state legislation on life issues), and **prayer** (40 Days for Life). **Pregnancy help: Waterleaf Women's Center:** 1-630-701-6270

Refugee Support Group...

Sharing Parish...

This committee provides tuition assistance to students at three Catholic grammar schools in Aurora -- St. Rita of Cascia, St. Terese of Jesus, and St. Peter -- by sponsoring a yearly "mega" Garage Sale to raise funds.

St. Vincent de Paul Society ...

Provides emergency assistance to anyone living within our parish boundaries, meet with those who come to the parish in need of financial help, and manage the donation drop off bins, year around, located outside the Narthex, next to the Food Pantry donations.

SMMP Pastoral Council

How we serve the parish

The Pastoral Council is composed of one representative from each of the four commissions (Administration, Christian Education, Christian Service, and Christian Worship), as well as six elected at-large members, and the Pastor. The Council meets the first Tuesday of every month, except July and August. The meetings are open to all members of the parish, and parishioner input is welcomed.

The Council assists and advises the Pastor in guiding, unifying, and coordinating the structure and workings of the parish and the parish community. The Council listens to parishioners, hears specific proposals of parishioners, and initiates proposals to improve the lives of the parishioners and promote the parish mission.

The Council discusses and decides subjects in accordance with a published agenda. Items for agenda consideration may be submitted to the parish office, and any parishioner may ask to be put on the agenda to make a presentation to the Council at the regularly scheduled meeting. Finally, the members of the Pastoral Council may be addressed directly by anyone, simply by addressing an e-mail to: pastoralcouncil@smmp.com. Each member of the Council will receive a copy of any such communication.

Administration Commission

The Administration Commission attends to the effective stewardship of financial, physical, and human resources at SMMP. The commission assists in the oversight of financial affairs, building facilities, and personnel policies and practices.

Christian Formation Commission

Keeps updated on current programs and makes recommendations concerning these programs

- Considers and develops new programs
- Seeks feedback from the parish and communicates the parishioners' concerns and needs
- Discusses, monitors, and approves CFC budget
- Reviews and approves policy

Christian Service Commission

The CSC's responsibility is to provide opportunities to serve God and those in need. The CSC coordinates, plans, assesses needs, and aids in establishing the ministry efforts of the parish. The CSC serves as a link with agencies of the Diocese involved in various aspects of social ministry.

The CSC serves to raise the consciousness of our parish community regarding:

- The biblical basis for social ministry
- The social teachings of the Church
- The social issues that confront Christians in today's society
- The human needs of people

The CSC meets human needs by: attending to the immediate needs of people who come to us; acting to deal with the root causes of the problems; speaking out on behalf of others; and empowering others to act on their own behalf.

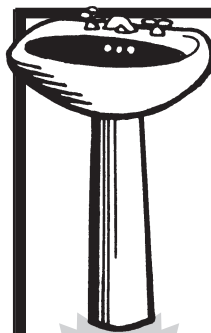

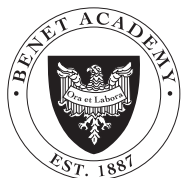
