

All In Ministry

All In Ministry (AIM) exists to encourage every member and attendee to be involved in some variety of ministries. Every member and attendee of League City United Methodist Church is encouraged to find a ministry in which to participate. The All In Ministry program is based on the philosophy that people who are involving themselves in ministries that are meaningful are the most contagious witnesses for our Lord and His church.

Ministries may be writing notes, teaching, singing, ushering, participating in any of dozens of opportunities, or initiating a service you've created yourself. Our ministries are as varied as our members and our members' gifts. This rich array of active talent makes our church alive and exciting and effective at doing so much so well.

It is our church's goal to have every member and attendee involved in a ministry so that each can assume the responsibility, privilege and joy of finding a place to serve. We believe that each member is called by God to serve. As you choose your ministry or ministries, you will find rich fellowship and a great sense of fulfillment as you serve in a ministry.

Sunday Morning Worship

11:00am Traditional Worship Service: This service offers music sung by the Sanctuary Choir, traditional hymns and liturgy, as well as a relevant message brought by our senior pastor Rev. Joel McMahon, IV.

9:00am Magnify (Contemporary Worship Service): This service is less formal and incorporates contemporary music in a relaxed atmosphere. A message is brought by our senior pastor Rev. Joel McMahon, IV.

A nursery is available for infants to children 4 years of age during all worship services.

Children & Youth Sunday School Classes

Children's Sunday School: 10am every Sunday. Children may participate in activities centered on stories from the Bible. Children make crafts and learn lessons from adults who love the children and love our Lord Jesus. Sunday School is available for children of all ages, and our nursery is available for the infants. (See Children's Ministry for Children's Sunday School information.)

Youth Sunday School: 10am Youth ages 6th-12th grade participate in studies geared to their age, along with challenges and concerns unique to students. We have youth from over 10 area schools and 3 area school districts! Our classes are grouped into Jr. High and Sr. High. Sunday School rooms are located upstairs.

Adult Sunday School

VOYAGERS Room 135: The Voyagers are primarily single and married adults in their 30's-40's who study topics that enhance their Christian walk. This class is extremely active in the church with almost every class member involved in one or more church activities, committees, etc. "Voyagers on the Move" blossomed out of this class and consists of family field trips to fun, inexpensive (sometimes free!) places to promote quality family time. Find us on Facebook! (Voyagers on the Move) The class enjoys being together, whether it's doing service projects around the church, eating dinner together at a restaurant, or gathering at someone's home for a party and fellowship.

SHEPHERDS Room 132: This is a class comprised of couples and singles ages 40's-50's with children of all ages. The class enjoys studying the Bible and how it is relevant to daily life. They also enjoy fellowship outside of the classroom.

AGAPE Room 158: This class is a wide mix of ages and experiences, but are all bound with a common love for understanding God's Word and how to live out His Word through our lives. We spend equal time in the Old and New Testaments as we seek to understand how Jesus is revealed in God's Word from Genesis through Revelation.

PAIRS & SPARES Room 134: This is a class comprised of adults (60's and older) who enjoy hearing and discussing different ideas about scripture and the Christian experience. Most of our children are out of the house, so our interests have changed from "parenting" to "grand-parenting" and dealing with life in the middle years and beyond.

SEEKERS Room 156: This is a class comprised of adults 60+ who study a variety of Bible-to-life issues. The class members are motivated and inspired in their participation and service to the church on a daily basis, and they also enjoy getting together for food, fun and fellowship outside of class time.

WOMEN OF THE WELL Room 154: This is a class comprised of women of all ages who focus on the values, service and ties of the family of God to all God's children. The class offers lessons of hope, wisdom, generosity, love, integrity, courage and humility with an emphasis on strengthening our relationship with God and our worship of Jesus through the study of God's Word and Spirit-led discussions.

FAMILY TIES (Room 166) is made up of adults mostly in their 50's or older but all are welcome. We study a wide variety of subjects and welcome those who struggle with the established viewpoint. We bring in our experiences to understanding and applying Christian lessons to our lives.

Other Adult Ministries

Adult Bible Studies: Several Bible studies take place during the school year, some of short duration and some of longer duration. Registration for long-term studies usually takes place in August and the schedule mirrors the school schedule. Short-term studies are scheduled around times and topics of interest (e.g., Advent studies, Lenten studies, summer sessions, etc.)

Men at 10 Bible Study: Men of all ages meet at 10:00am on Thursdays in room 158 to explore passages of the Bible and their implications on everyday life.

Women's Bible Studies (LIFT: Ladies in Faith Together):

LCUMC has always encouraged Bible study and small group growth. Growing spiritually with other women is accomplished through learning about the Bible by studying books and watching videos from various sources, such as Elizabeth George, Leah Adams, Beth Moore, and Adam Hamilton. We lift up each other as we enjoy socializing, sharing prayer concerns, and celebrating joys. Sometimes, we even bring treats to pass around to everyone! The group also occasionally joins together for lunch. Everyone is invited to attend and bring a friend. LIFT meets on Wednesdays at 10:30am in the conference room in the administrative hall of the church.

Disciple Series Studies: The basic courses have been offered over the past decade. As interest arises, facilitators are available to lead a new group through gaining a greater insight into the Word of Life. The plan for 2021 calls for the basic *Disciple* course to be offered again. If you are interested in being a part of this or a future *Disciple* series study, call the church office and your interest will be directed to the current contact.

Topical Studies: Special seminars have been offered over time.

They address particular needs including: strengthening marriages, strengthening families, parenting, grief recovery, divorce recovery, health and wellness, budgeting, and other relevant topics.

Children's Weekday Ministries

Creative Corners is a Christian Kindergarten, Preschool, and Children's Day Out where children grow spiritually, intellectually, physically and socially. The school is a ministry of League City United Methodist Church, and has been educating and inspiring children for over 40 years. Creative Corners provides flexible and affordable childcare that families can customize to their unique needs. Our teachers are highly trained, highly motivated and highly responsive professionals, dedicated not just to childcare, but also to laying the groundwork for your child's future academic and social success. Creative Corners Kindergarten curriculum standards meet or exceed standards established by Texas Education Agency (TEA). Creative Corners is licensed by the state of Texas and each teacher has undergone a criminal history check, FBI fingerprint, CPR certified, First Aid trained, and retains 24 clock hours of training a year. We have a low teacher to student ratio, so act fast to secure a spot for your child!

Children's Day Out: is offered for children ages 18 months to 2 years of age from 9:00am-2:00pm on Monday through Thursday and 9:00am-Noon on Fridays. during the school year. Any combinations of days are available Monday through Friday, depending on enrollment.

Creative Corners Preschool: is conducted for children 3 and 4 years of age (birthday as of Sept. 1) and meets on either a 2, 3, or 5 day schedule from 9:00am-Noon, Mondays through Thursdays and 9:00am-Noon on Fridays. Creative Corners is a developmentally appropriate program specifically designed to prepare your child for kindergarten.

Kindergarten classes are taught by a state of Texas certified teacher. Students must be 5 years age on or before Sept. 1st. They meet Monday through Thursday, 9:00am-2:00 and 9:00-Noon on Friday.

Nursery Ministries

Nursery and Child Care: Preschool children enjoy clean facilities with an environment of security, warmth, and loving care. Our trained staff attends to children ages infant to Kindergarten on Sunday morning from 8:15am to 12:10pm, and also for meetings, studies, etc. during the week. Nursery is in Rooms 145 and 128.

Extended Nursery: Nursery is provided for children ages infant through 5th grade on choir/bell practice night from 5:50pm to 8:30pm in Rooms 145 and 128.

Acolytes: Children in grades 3rd and up are invited to serve as Acolytes. They are invited to serve as part of the ministry team on a rotating basis.

Children's Sermons: During the 11 o'clock worship service, 2nd-5th Sundays, the children are invited to the front of the church to hear the children's sermon.

Children's Church: Children's Church is offered (during the school year) for children ages kindergarten-3rd grade. Please check children in before 11:00am services. The Children's Worship Room is located upstairs in room 135. Children's Church is available 2nd-5th Sundays

Vacation Bible School: One week each summer the church comes alive with the presence and energy of many children, youth, and adults. For one week the volunteer staff and children experience immersion in a new time and place to learn Bible stories, verses, and songs.

Confirmation: Confirmation classes are held each year for 5th grade students as they begin to form their ideas and opinions of who God is and His purpose for their life. They learn about their church and the Methodist church in general. The Confirmation experience includes the class time on Sunday mornings and afternoons, field trips and a retreat to help students mentally and spiritually prepare for their decision to become a full member of the church family. They walk away from the class with new friends, a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and prepared to take the next step and join the youth group.

Praise Band is a group that helps to lead our 9:00am Contemporary Worship known as *Magnify*. Rehearsals are on Thursdays at 7:00pm. It is comprised of people who have various backgrounds in music and are gifted in leading the congregation in worship on Sunday. (Audition required.)

Frequently Asked Questions

WORSHIP

Do you have traditional and/or contemporary worship services?

The 11:00am worship service is a traditional worship service that offers music sung by the Sanctuary Choir, traditional hymns and liturgy, as well as a relevant message given by our senior pastor Rev. Joel McMahon, IV.

The 9:00am Magnify contemporary worship service is less formal and incorporates contemporary music in a relaxed atmosphere. A message is brought by our senior pastor Rev. Joel McMahon, IV.

Can I get a recording of the Sunday sermon?

The sermons from our worship services are video-recorded each week and are posted on the LCUMC FaceBook page.

CHILDREN

Are children always welcome in the worship services?

Children are always welcome to attend worship services.

Is childcare available during worship services and other events?

Childcare is available for all worship services. Childcare for other events varies and is frequently arranged based on the anticipated need.

How can the nursery staff locate me if they need me during the worship service?

Parents can be contacted by a pager they receive when they check their child into the nursery.

Are there diaper changing facilities?

Diaper changing stations are located in the men's and women's restrooms located in the Family Life Center.

I would like my child to attend worship with me. Is there anything special for children in worship?

All worship services, except for the first Sunday of the month, have a special time when children are invited to come forward to hear a message for their age level. Worship folders that contain a variety of activities are also available for children.

COMMUNION

When do you celebrate communion?

Communion is served on the first Sunday of every month during both the 9:00am and 11:00am services. Communion is also served during services on Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday and Christmas Eve.

Can you bring communion to me at my seat?

Communion will be brought to those who are unable to come forward during the service. You may remain seated and indicate to an usher that you would like to be served.

Is gluten-free bread available at communion?

Yes.

HOW TO JOIN THE CHURCH

Do I have to talk to someone first about joining LCUMC?

No, you do not have to talk to someone first. We would always welcome a chance to get to know you before you join, but it is certainly not a requirement. It is important to us that you feel like you belong before you join. We receive members by confession of faith in Jesus, transfer from another Christian church, or by renewal of their vows of Christian discipleship.

Do I have to walk up front to join?

We prefer that you do. When someone joins a church, we want to give our current members the opportunity to renew their vows with you, pledge their support to you, and meet their new brother or sister in Christ. We celebrate new members. Our congregation likes to have a chance to welcome you personally. If for any reason you cannot come forward, please consult with one of the pastors.

Can my children join when I join?

Children are an important part of our church. Children, 5th grade and younger, are received as baptized or constituent members and are encouraged to participate in 5th grade Confirmation. Youth, 7th grade and above, are received as full members of the church when they join and are given the opportunity to be part of a confirmation class for their age group.

BAPTISM

Do I have to be baptized to be a member of LCUMC?

All those who are received as full members must be baptized. If you were previously baptized by another Christian denomination we do not require that you be re-baptized.

My children need to be baptized. How do I go about making these arrangements?

Please contact the pastor to set up a time to meet and discuss the baptisms. A date will then be set.

PASTORAL CARE

Are there certain times when I should contact the pastor?

Please contact a pastor when you or a family member is going into the hospital, when there is a birth or death in the family, and when you have a special concern about which you would like to speak with someone.

Where should I go if I have an appointment with a pastor or other staff member?

During the week you can park in the main parking lot off League City Parkway West or Turner Road and come in under the breezeway and through the double doors. The main office is located to the back left of the Welcome Center. The receptionist will be glad to let the staff member know that you are here and will assist you in locating their office.

In the event that you come “after work hours,” there is a door bell on the double doors of the Family Life. Ring the doorbell and someone will let you in if they are in the office.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Do you have handicapped parking spaces?

Handicapped or Low Mobility parking spaces are just outside the Family Life Center doors in the main parking lot off of League City Parkway or Turner Drive.

Do you have handicapped restrooms?

Handicap restrooms are located in the Family Life Center.

PARKING

Where is the main parking for the church?

Our main parking is accessible from either League City Parkway West or Turner Road.

Do you have reserved parking for guests?

Reserved guest parking is located in the main parking lot.

Do you have handicapped parking spaces?

Handicapped or Low Mobility parking spaces are just outside the Family Life Center doors in the main parking lot.

MISCELLANEOUS

How do I go about receiving a church newsletter?
