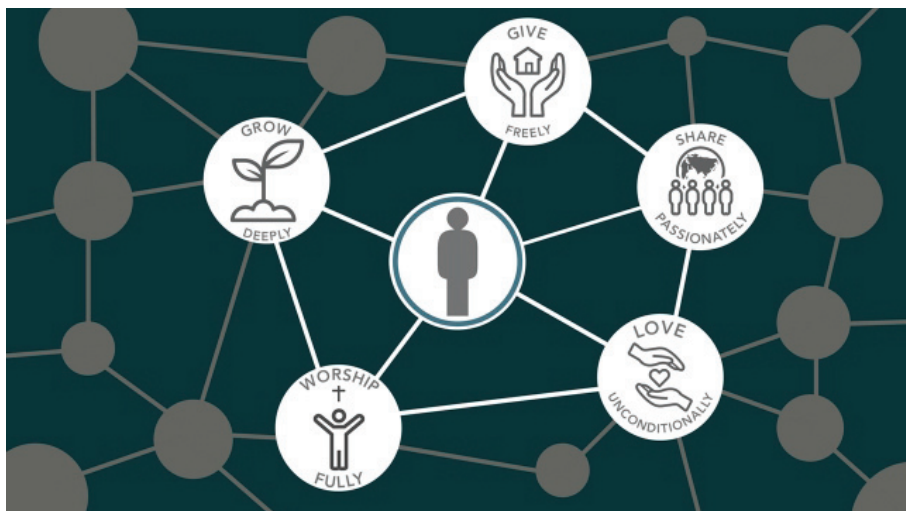

### Early Traditional Worship Service in the Chapel

Nursery is available.

### Traditional Worship Service in the Sanctuary

The Traditional Worship Service begins at 10:30am in the Chapel using a traditional format of liturgy and music. The CUMC Chancel Church Choir regularly leads the congregation in hymns from The United Methodist Hymnal as well as providing their own choral and/or solo performances. The CUMC Chancel Church Choir is accompanied by the church organist and piano from the music director. Nursery Care is available during this service.

### Contemporary Worship Service in the Sanctuary

The Contemporary Service at 10:15am in the Sanctuary follows the traditional format in an informal way with joyful Contemporary Christian music from our Praise Band (members are youth through adults) every Sunday. Nursery Care and Children's Church are both available during this service.

## Early Childhood Education Ministries

Central United Methodist Church has two licensed weekday programs for your young children. Whether you need care and education every business day or only a couple, whether full-time or part-time, CUMC offers several choices to you with warm, loving and trained staff. Please contact Kris Mickna, Executive Director of Child Development, or call 479-636-1630 x616 with any questions you may have to help you find what best fits your needs.

### Central Child Care Center

Central Child Care Center is an outreach program of CUMC providing both **full-time** and **part-time** childcare for children ages 6 weeks old until they enter Kindergarten. It is designed to provide a safe, happy and healthy learning and growing environment for infants, toddlers and preschoolers. Our primary goal is to help each child attain his/her greatest potential by providing a positive self-concept through educational, emotional and physical development. CCCC is accredited through Better Beginnings of Arkansas. We use the Adventures in Learning curriculum for toddlers and preschool age, and Connecting with Infants curriculum for infants through 18 months old. Children are given a wide variety of social and physical activities, while enhancing their emotional and spiritual growth. They participate in chapel time, library time, art, music, science, math, learning centers and imaginative play. We understand the importance of early childhood education and as we strive to connect with each child, they are given every learning opportunity that they will need to be prepared for Kindergarten.

**Full-time** care is provided Monday through Friday from 6:30am-5:30pm for all ages year-round.

**Part-time** care (Mother's Day Out program) is provided Monday through Thursday from 8:00am-2:30pm and follows the traditional Rogers Public School calendar. For preschool age children who also participate in Tiny Tots, a half-day option is available. You may choose any or all days available. The part-time program also offers a 6-week summer session.

**Clubhouse Central** occurs during the summer months for **school age** children that have completed Kindergarten through age 12. Summer hours for this program are 7:00am-5:30pm and provides safe, fun programming here in the church facility as well as transportation to area activities in our community.

All children, whether members of CUMC or not, are welcome to attend. For more information, contact Jennifer Singh, Director, at 479-636-1224.

### **Tiny Tots Preschool**

Tiny Tots Preschool is a 3-hour/multiple days a week program designed to help each child learn with more joy, more meaning, more purpose, and more satisfaction so that they might make a smoother transition into Kindergarten. This program follows the traditional Rogers Public School Calendar. We hope to pave the way to successful learning, coupled with the sheer joy of discovering new and different concepts through reading, writing, oral language, listening, math, science, socialization, art, music and physical education. Tiny Tots is offered to three and four year olds and is based on the public school system entry birth dates. Four year olds attend for a half day on Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Monday through Friday. Three year olds attend on Tuesday and Thursday or Monday, Wednesday, Friday. ### **Confirmation**

Confirmation is a time where students are given the opportunity to grow in faith together with a mentor and ultimately confirm their own faith before God and their church community. Gravity offers one session of Confirmation each school year for students 8th grade and above, running winter through mid-spring. Registration is required for Confirmation.

## Giving back to God

*Jesus talked about money and possessions more than any other subject except the Kingdom of God. The reason is because He knew that the pursuit and accumulation of money and possessions can steal our heart away from God more than anything else. Money isn't bad, but the love of money is the root of all kinds of evil and has caused many people to wander away from the true faith. (1 Timothy 6:10)*

The key to having a proper relationship with money is to learn to give freely (one of our Connecting Points) back to God a meaningful portion of what God has given you. To do that you have to realize that everything you have is God's and was given to you by God. Also realizing how much God has given you compared to the rest of the world helps you grasp how blessed financially you are.
