

Parish Boundaries

North boundary

- Beginning at 10th & Washington Blvd.
- West on Washington to the point where it intersects State Avenue
- West on State to Francis Rd. (61st Street)

West boundary

· South on Francis Rd. (61st St.) to the Kansas River

South boundary

- Follow Kansas River East to a point due south of 38th St.
- Follow the Union Pacific tracks to 18th St.

East boundary

- North on 18th St. to Ridge Ave.* East on Ridge Ave. to 12th St.
- North on 12th St. to Ohio
- · East on Ohio to 10th St.
- North on 10th St. to Washington Blvd.

Directions:

If driving from I-70, go North on 18th St. Expressway.

 Go to Central Ave, turn right, go to 14th St and turn left, go to Orville, and you will be at the SE corner of the parking lot.

OR

2) Cross Central Ave and go to the next street, Grandview.Turn right and go 4 blocks to 14th street.Turn left and go one block to the SE corner of the parking lot.

Note: There are many one way streets around the Cathedral. The above routes are the easiest. Also, look for signs on 18th street or Central Ave that guide one to the Cathedral.

Sacraments

BAPTISM–As in all Catholic Parishes, the parent(s) should be registered, active members of the Parish. "Active" means that the parent (s) should be practicing and living their Faith through Sunday worship and participation in parish activities.

For parishioners, contact Parish Office, 913-371-0840.

Non-Parishioners need to participate in the Baptismal preparation in their own parish and their pastor needs to send permission to the Cathedral pastor. Then after the reception of those documents, he can set a date with the parents. Baptisms are generally celebrated after the 4:00 pm Saturday evening Mass or after the 12:00 pm Sunday morning Mass. Godparents must be practicing Catholics and, if married, they must be married in the Catholic Church.

WEDDINGS– Couples need to contact the pastor, 913-371-0840, to set an appointment and begin the process. Couples need to participate in the required Archdiocesan Marriage Preparation Program.

<u>Non–parishioners</u> will need written permission from their own pastor, and their own pastor is responsible for the marriage preparation.

Couples need to contact the pastor a minimum of 6 months prior to the anticipated date.

SISTERS OF CHARITY
