How have COVID Restrictions Affected Lord of Life Lutheran Church?

We have made every effort to continue our ministries; however due to COVID restrictions most ministries will be a little different. Some things are being streamed online and on Facebook; some meetings and Bible studies are either via Zoom or a combination of Zoom and in person; some ministries are temporarily on hold for now.

Safety precautions are in place for in person services and meetings. Reflective Electro Magnetic Energy air purifying units have been installed on the A/C systems throughout the building. All rooms in the building are cleaned, including the Sanctuary after every use utilizing CDC approved electrostatic sprayers to clean all flat surfaces. Groups meetings held in person are asked to clean after themselves, with products that we provide. Room size limits are in place to ensure proper social distancing. In person worship and meetings require masks and health questionnaires to be completed by all attending for contact tracing.

Lord of Life wants you to feel as comfortable as possible when you decide to come back to in person services or meetings and we hope these additional tools and methods will help you feel safe while you are here.



Junior High Ministry

Our confirmation ministry is a 2-year instruction of Lutheran beliefs of the faith. When a baby is baptized, parents promise to raise that child in a church community. When that child becomes older, he/she begins this term of instruction.

Teens are taught as a large group and then broken up into small groups with adult faith mentors as leaders. These adults make a 2-year commitment to see their small group through this time of instruction, thereby, creating a meaningful and lasting relationship with each teenager. At the end of the 2-years, the teen takes responsibility for his/her own faith journey and relationship with God through a ceremony called “Affirmation of Baptism.”



Our 7th & 8th grade junior high ministry is a mix of learning, serving, and fellowship events.

Our regular weekly ministry happens during the school year on Wednesdays from 7:00 - 8:30 pm, as well as during Sunday School. In addition to our weekly ministry, other events such as retreats, and summer mission trips are offered.

Senior High Ministry

Our 9th - 12th grade ministry is also based on Bible studies, servant, and fellowship events. During the school year, we offer opportunities weekly – Sunday morning Sunday School at 9:50 am, and Sunday night ministry, from 6:30 - 8:00 pm. The activity changes week to week as our adult faith mentors provide meaningful opportunities to build relationships with our teens. Friends are always welcome to join us upstairs in the Senior High Room, Rm 25.

In addition to Sunday nights, our Senior Higher group participate in an annual mission trip in the summer, weekend retreats at our regional camp, and other events to promote Christian growth and learning.

Post High School Ministry

Our goal as a congregation is a program to maintain contact and connection with our post-high school young adults, communicating primarily by texting and seasoned with opportunities to share a cup of Starbucks coffee. An occasional care package is sent to college students and military personnel. At Lord of Life Lutheran Church there are many opportunities to connect, serve, and grow your faith. Connecting through service is a great way to support the ministries at Lord of Life and to get to know members of Lord of Life.

Sunday Greeters

Greeters welcome members and guests who arrive at worship on Sunday mornings. They are the first impression of who we are at Lord of Life.

Welcome Desk

Welcome desk helpers greet visitors and provide information, typically serving once a month and choose from one of three different shifts.

Welcome Center Coffee/Donuts

Volunteers prepare and set out the coffee in the Welcome Center as well as the donuts and bagels that are delivered on Sunday morning for fellowship between and after Sunday worship services.

Park and Ride

Volunteers drive one of 2 carts on Sunday morning for 1-1/2 hour shifts and can choose from 3 different shifts. We also offer park and ride during Advent and Lent. We transport folks from McCullough Middle School parking lot to Lord of Life. After the service we take riders back to the McCullough parking lot for their cars. This is a great way to meet people and make Lord of Life a welcoming church.

New Member Class

Opportunities to join Lord of Life through our Discovery Class happen 3 times a year. We will cover various topics such as: Getting to Know You, Lutheranism 101, Worship at Lord of Life, and Ways to Connect.

Hospitality Team

Hospitality coordinates, trains, and schedules volunteers to assist in church wide events such as Fundraisers for Pastor's Discretionary Fund, Potlucks, Round Tables, Sunday Morning Coffee, Fellowship Events.
