Sunday Worship Service Schedule

September through May 8:30 & 11 a.m. June through the first Sunday of September 10 a.m.

Special worship services are held on Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, and Christmas Eve.

Hearing Amplifiers, Large Type Bulletins & Hymnals are Available A hearing loop encircles the transepts and the pews in the center part of the sanctuary and enables anyone with a telecoil, or t-coil, in a hearing aid or cochlear implant to receive a customized sound and improved hearing experience.

Holy Communion is open to all believers and is served on the first Sunday of the month and at other seasonal celebrations. Gluten free bread is served.

Worshipping with Children Families with children are welcome in our worship services. Children's worship packets are available on the tables located just inside the Sanctuary doors.

Child Care (birth to age 4) is also available during each worship services and during Sunday School in the Nursery.

The Parlor provides an alternative, comfort space for families who prefer to worship together with young children and the freedom for the children to freely move around.

Children's Moments & Children's Worship (ages 4 through 5th grade) are offered at the second worship service. Children may leave to attend Children's Worship in the Chapel following the Children's Moments. Caregivers are welcome to accompany children in Children's Worship. Children 6th grade and older are invited to remain in worship.

Spiritual Formation and Small Group Opportunities

Sunday School meets from 9:45 to 10:45 a.m. September through May.

- 20s & Up Walk in and view a DVD based curriculum, with Christian topics presented by theologians and progressive thinkers, followed up by engaging discussion and exploration of Christian views for today's world. Meets in the Youth Room.
- **The Adult Bible Study** Using the International Bible Lessons curriculum this class engages in stimulating discussion that explores the biblical message and how to apply it to daily life. Meets in the Parlor.
- **The Kitchen Class** This class engages in topical Christian conversation and book studies. Class time always includes time to share individual cares and concerns. Meets in the Kitchen.
- Word Among Us This class reads together one or more of the lectionary texts for the week, looks at the historical context and the life applications for the scriptures. Meets in the Chapel.
- **Project Sunday School** The children are introduced to Jesus and God's Word through Bible stories and together developing drama to share in worship. For children age 4 through grade 6.
- **Youth Sunday School** Using 52 Great Bible Studies curriculum, the youth look for God and faith in their own lives. For youth grades 7 12. Meets is room 125.

There are short term and seasonal classes and workshops offered throughout the year. Check the monthly Maple Leaf Newsletter and our website.

Tween and Teen Opportunities

T.M.I. (**Teen Ministry Inc.**) grades 4th – 6th grade come together twice a month on Sunday evenings from 4:00-5:30 to learn to love God, neighbors, and themselves.

Youth Group grades 7th through 12th come together during the school year on Sundays from 4:00-5:30 in the Youth Room for fun, sharing, community building, Bible reflection and mission work.

Youth Mission Trip: annually a weeklong mission trip is offered to high school students.

Vacation Bible School occurs every summer as a weeklong evening ministry for children ages birth through 6th grade.

Music and Drama

Chancel Choir provides music leadership at the second worship service from September through May. The Chancel Choir participates in special services during Advent and Lent and offers major works with orchestra. Rehearsals are Thursdays at 7:30 p.m.

JuBELLate offers handbell music during worship September-May. Rehearsals are on Thursdays at 6:30 p.m.

NewSong is a multigenerational ensemble that sings contemporary Christian music approximately once a month in worship with a variety of instruments used for accompaniment; additional opportunities for small groups (duet, trio, etc.) to sing as schedule permits.

Maple Grove Players offer chancel drama during worship. The Players also perform at special events and offer drama outreach to the community.

Maple Grove is a Stephen Ministry and H.E.R.O.E.S. Care Congregation

Stephen Ministry is one-to-one caring by trained lay ministers who have responded to Christ's call to love one another. Through this confidential relationship, those who are facing a crisis or life challenge receive love and care to support them.

H.E.R.O.E.S. Care Hometown Support Program that builds on Stephen Ministry and includes additional training designed to meet the unique needs of service members and their families with the goal of preventing and mitigating the psychological, moral and spiritual injuries that often accompany deployment.

Some EMIM Community Service Opportunities

- Abused Children Outreach program reaches out to abused children and their families through partnership with The Center for Family Safety and Healing (TCFSH).
- **Bethlehem on Broad** food boxes are packed and distributed two Saturdays in December.
- CRC Sunday Breakfast prepares and serves breakfast to CRC clients.
- CRC Monthly Dinner serves dinner at CRC to the community on the first Tuesday of each month. All are welcome to provide food, come to serve and/or to dine.
- **Feed My Sheep** collects and delivers canned goods to NNEMAP Food Pantry and Clintonville-Beechwold Community Resources Center (CRC), and sandwiches to the Faith on 8th.
- Feed the World Sunday In late August our Sunday morning worship becomes Sunday service as we prepare food for local, national and international distribution.
- **NNEMAP** provides lunch to approximately 100 clients the last Monday of the month.
- Pastor's Food Pantry packs sack lunches the first Sunday of each month to deliver to CRC to meet the needs of their clients.
- Thanksgiving Community Dinner is a free traditional meal served at Maple Grove on Thanksgiving Day where all are welcome.












The Maple Grove Building Map
