

RCIA

Rite of Catholic Initiation of Adults

Adults who are not baptized or who are baptized in another Christian faith tradition and seek to embrace the Catholic faith, participate in a process called RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Adults are fully initiated into the Catholic Church during this process, celebrating Baptism, if needed, Confirmation and First Eucharist.

Anyone thinking about becoming Catholic and those Catholics who never received their First Holy Communion or Confirmation are encouraged to learn more about our RCIA Program.

Baptism

The Gospels tell us that Jesus began his public ministry by having himself baptized by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. Though he was without sin, he allowed himself to be numbered among sinners, already "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." Through Baptism, the Christian must go down into the water with Jesus in order to rise with him, be reborn of water and the Spirit...and "walk in newness of life." (CCC 536-37)

Parents who wish to have their child baptized at Holy Child Parish are required to attend a Pre Jordan class. Godparents are also welcome and encouraged to attend. Classes are held on the first Wednesday of each month at 7 pm. The theology of the sacrament is explored as well as parish guidelines regarding the conferral of the sacrament and the roles of both parents and godparents.

Baptisms are celebrated during Mass at St. Teresa Church on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of most months and at St Maria Goretti Church on the 3rd Sunday of most months. Reconciliation

Jesus gave his apostles the authority to forgive sins. As it is written, "Whose sins you forgive, they shall be forgiven... (Luke 20-21-23)."

The sacrament of Reconciliation offers genuine healing of sin's effects through a personal meeting in faith with the forgiving Christ.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is also often referred to as *Penance* or *Confession*. Each of these names refer to a different aspect of the Sacrament in which we **CONFESS** our sins and do **PENANCE** as a sign of our new **RECONCILIATION** with God and the Church. The baptized faithful are invited to celebrate this Sacrament of Healing beginning at the age of seven because the Church has deemed this as the "age of discretion" when children can understand right from wrong and therefore recognize their need for reconciliation and forgiveness.


First Holy Communion

Two-year parish preparation

The Eucharist is the sacrament of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. On the night before he died, Jesus took bread, blessed it and gave it to his disciples and said, "Take it, this is my body (Mark 14: 22-24)." Then Jesus took a cup of wine, gave thanks, and said, "This is my blood, which will be given up for you. Do this in memory of me (Luke 22:19)." At every Mass, the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and we are invited to an intimate union with our Lord.

At Holy Child Parish, children typically receive First Holy Communion in the spring of 2nd grade. Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is a two-year process that incorporates classroom faith formation, family sessions and retreats. Candidates are expected to participate weekly in Sunday Mass with their families and have an appreciation and understanding of the Eucharist, appropriate for their age.

Confirmation Preparation

Two-year parish preparation

Confirmation celebrates what was started for us during our Baptism. It celebrates the acceptance of God's presence in our life as well as our decision to participate more fully within the life of the church. With such a commitment comes the importance of exploration, guidance and instruction.

The Confirmation Program at Holy Child Parish is a two year comprehensive program that is about faith formation and faith integration. Through continuous participation in monthly candidate and family based sessions, retreat experiences, service opportunities, as well as actively participation within the Mass, our candidates are given a change to gain a fuller understanding of the elements within the Sacrament of Confirmation. Each experience allows candidates an opportunity to connect their faith education to faith experiences by linking teachable moments to the activity.

Marriage Preparation

According to the Gospel of John (Jn 2: 1-12), Jesus performed his first miracle - at his mother's request - at a wedding feast. The Church sees in Christ's presence at the wedding at Cana the confirmation of the goodness of marriage and the proclamation that thenceforth marriage will be an efficacious sign of Christ's presence. Just as water was transformed into wine, the matrimonial covenant between baptized persons has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament (CCC 1601).

Marriage Preparation Programs are called Pre Cana because they recall this Gospel passage and remind us that Christ is at the center of every Christian marriage.

Holy Child's Pre Cana program is held twice a year and offers engaged couples a deeper understanding of the sacrament of Marriage, family life, adjustments on marriage, finances, communication and conflict resolution. Sessions are held on a Friday evening and all day Saturday concluding with the 4PM Mass.
