



Sister Parish St. Francis of Assisi

The objectives of our Sister Parish relationship are to help both parishes meet their spiritual, fellowship, educational and economic needs and to build an intercultural understanding of the global Church.

There have been several mutual endeavors:

- Resurrection's Hearts & Hands Ministry made dresses for the young girls of St. Francis, as well as wool hats, scarves, blankets and mittens.
- The two parishes have swapped Pastors for a weekend and held several picnics together in Blountstown.
- The needy children of St. Francis' religious education classes receive Christmas gifts, Nike sneakers, and backpacks filled with school supplies from Resurrection at different times throughout the year.

We will continue to look for ways to support St. Francis.

Retirement Home Ministry

Advent Outreach and Children's Gift Drive



The Sunday before the start of Advent, tags are hung on a Giving Tree in the Gathering Space asking for gifts (toys, clothing, etc.) for needy children identified by our sister parish, St. Francis of Assisi, Catholic Charities, St. Vincent de Paul Society and others in our community. Parishioners

select tags, purchase the gifts requested, and return them to the trees. Contributions also can be made to purchase bicycles and helmets.

Hearts and Hands



Hearts and Hands is a ministry committed to making clothing for several needy groups. Since 2009, hundreds of lap robes and/or shawls have been knitted and crocheted for patients of Grand Boulevard Health and Rehab Center and many homebound persons. Caps and gift sets of baby blankets with matching hats and booties are knitted for newborns at Sacred Heart Hospital. These gifts have also gone to other newborns

requested by parishioners and others. Another project involves sewing clothing for the needy in specific African countries.

The group meets on Thursdays 1:30-3:30 PM in the parish hall. Some members do work for the ministry, but do not come to the gatherings. Our seasonal visitors continue to produce items even after they return home, mailing in their completed work. Prayer is an important part of the ministry, together and individually. The group views the gifts as artifacts of prayer given with a warm, written message of loving and caring. The Men of Resurrection (MORE)

The Men of Resurrection (MORE) is a group committed to fellowship and service. MORE is always there when volunteers are needed. The primary fund raiser, The Spring Fling, generated donations to local charities in excess of \$26,000 in 2019. The MORE sponsored "Bag Program" continuously supplies food and diapers to those in need.

Food Collection and Distribution



For years the Men of Resurrection (MORE) have been collecting food for our local Catholic Charities food pantry. Grocery bags are passed out after all weekend Masses with a list of needed items. Our generous parishioners and visitors return the bags filled with food. MORE and Catholic Charities

partnered to send a mobile food pantry to Resurrection and Defuniak. The venture has been an astounding success.

If you would like to help MORE with this ministry, volunteer opportunities are as follows:

- Passing out bags after Masses
- Transporting filled bags from Resurrection to Catholic Charities in Fort Walton Beach
- Monthly Distribution of food: Freeport on the 1st Tuesday,
 Defuniak on the 3rd Tuesday and Resurrection on the 4th Tuesday

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul

Resurrection and St. Rita's Catholic Churches are partners in a St. Vincent



de Paul charter. Both churches contribute the volunteer effort and financial support needed to execute the mission of the society. The purpose of the charter is to provide financial help with food, gas, rent, utility bills, and prescription assistance to the needy of Miramar Beach, Santa Rosa Beach, and Freeport. The group helps over 250 families per year get through one crisis situation per family. This aid is not intended to provide long term

solutions, only temporary relief.

Volunteer time investment is only 3-4 weeks per year. Weekly responsibilities include:

- Monitoring the toll free number for assistance requests. (An average week is 4-5 client calls.)
- Phone screening the clients to determine eligibility
- Driving with a partner to the client's home to interview the client, assess the situation and potentially provide help.
